

MYSTIC VALLEY REGIONAL CHARTER SCHOOL

The Mystic Valley Regional Charter School adheres to the State of Massachusetts guidelines for school entry requirements. Below, please find the list of requirements for your child's grade.

KINDERGARTEN:

<u>Immunizations:</u>	5 DTP	2 Varicella (chicken pox)
	4 Polio	or written documentation from doctor
	2 MMR	of having had the disease.
	3 Hepatitis B	1 Lead screening test with the date and result noted.
		1 TB test or a statement of low risk

Physical Exam: Exam must be done within six months prior to school entry. You may use any medical form your doctor provides.

GRADES 1-6:

<u>Immunizations:</u>	≥4 DTP	1 Lead Screening test result
	≥3 Polio	3 Hepatitis B (grades K-5)
	2 MMR (grades 1-4)	1 TB test or a statement of low risk.

Physical Exam: A physical exam must be done (within one year) for all students entering Grade 4. You may use one your doctor provides.

GRADE 4:

<u>Immunizations:</u>	≥4 DTP	1 Lead Screening test result
	≥3 Polio	3 Hepatitis B (grades K-5)
	2 MMR (grades 1-3)	1 TB test or a statement of low risk.

Physical Exam: A physical exam must be done (within one year) for all students entering Grade 4. You may use any medical form your doctor provides.

GRADE 7:

<u>Immunizations:</u>	>4 DTP + Tetanus booster*	Varicella: <13yrs = 1 dose, ≥13 yrs = 2 doses
	≥3 Polio	(or letter from doctor stating date your child had
	2 MMR	Chickenpox).
	3 Hepatitis B	1 TB test or a statement of low risk
	* Tetanus Booster will also be required.	

Physical Exam: A physical exam must be done (within one year) for all students entering Grade 7. You may use any medical form your doctor provides.

Medications: If your child requires medication during school hours, there are consent forms that need to be completed. Please contact the school nurse and she will forward the consent forms to you or simply stop by the nurse's office when school starts and you may complete them at that time. If the medication your child requires during school hours is prescription medication, a medication order form also needs to be completed and signed by the prescribing physician.

Health conditions/concerns: If your child has any medical conditions or health concerns that you feel the school/ school nurse should be aware of, please bring it to our attention by consulting with the School Nurse.

Please provide documentation of the above requirements and return them to the school nurse as soon as possible for fall admission.

Every child must have this information on file before they are allowed to attend school.
