

¡Vamos a España! April Vacation to Spain in 2010

Dear Parent/Guardian:

I am very happy to inform you that our April Vacation Trip of 2010 will be to Spain. It may seem a long way off, but we are already trying to settle the price and start having your child or children sign up for a very memorable trip.

The trip will be from Saturday April 17th to April 24th, 2010, through *EF Educational Tours*. The cost of the trip if you enroll before April 1st of this year is \$2,160. This price includes all the sightseeing tours, transportation, hotels, and two meals per day. It also has a \$100 deduction if we sign up before April 1st, less than two weeks from now. The price is subject to change as per *EF's* policy. After this first deadline the program fee will likely increase. In order to lock this price in, *EF Tours* requires that you pay the \$95 Enrollment fee, which is a one-time fee. If your child is a Senior and paid the fee already for this year's trip, they would only need to register for the trip. If your child is a Junior and he/she decides to go on the Senior trip as well, they will not be charged again.

I would like all of you to know that the deadline to sign up for the trip is November 20th, 2009. Again, the price may go up if you enroll after April 1st, but you will have the option to sign up for the trip up until November 20th. For parents concerned with the economy, *EF Tours* has a Peace of Mind program that basically allows the withdrawal of a student from the trip if a parent/guardian loses their source of income.
