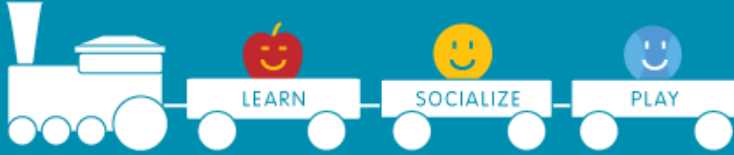

Please note a one-time registration fee of \$25 per student is required. A credited deposit of \$30 per week (or a family cap of \$400 for the summer) is required at the time of registration to ensure placement. **Deposits are credited towards respective weekly tuition, but are not refundable. Melrose Public Schools is pleased to announce summer enrichment programming for all elementary students currently enrolled in grades K-5 in Melrose. Education Stations, our after school enrichment program, will be extending the fun to provide summer camp adventures. Students will be grouped by grade to enjoy summer camp activities led by our trained staff of experienced teachers, enthusiastic college students and active mentor students. A registered nurse will be available to support the summer program. Dr. Josephson and her talented staff of building leads will head up Camp K.I.D.S., taking Melrose students on a summer world tour!

Camp K.I.D.S. - Kinesthetic and Interesting Days of Summer - is designed to make the most of physical activity, curiosity and warm weather. Plenty of opportunities for kinesthetic physical activity will be given through swimming, organized sports, cooperative games, water play, music/movement sessions and outdoor free play. Camp will be kept interesting through a variety of activities including field trips, building challenges, library literacy & computer lab time, cooking, arts & crafts and cultural exchange learning. Our goal at Camp K.I.D.S. is to help students pack the days of summer with fond memories and fun.

Campers will travel through weekly themes to experience the festive sights, sounds and tastes of summer around the globe. Camp K.I.D.S. will take place at the Roosevelt School, where campers will enjoy the open green space, play structures and indoor amenities that suit elementary-aged students. Field trips will be scheduled on Mondays, Wednesdays or Fridays, and destinations will include the Museum of Science, Stone Zoo, Boston Harbor Islands, Fenway Park, Children's Museum, and other fascinating venues. Students registered for the full/extended day option will take at least two off-site trips per week at no additional charge. Students registered for the half-day or Tues/Thurs options may participate in field trips for an additional fee as space permits.

Summer camp sessions run in weekly blocks. Parents may select a camp schedule that works best for their family and vary it per week of attendance. Half-day, full-day, extended-day and Tuesday/Thursday options are available each week. Please see the reverse side for scheduling and pricing information. Programming will begin on Monday, June 21<sup>st</sup>, and conclude on Friday, August 13<sup>th</sup>. **Registration will begin March 1<sup>st</sup> and conclude April 2<sup>nd</sup>.** A one-time registration fee of \$25 per student is required. A deposit of \$30 per week (or a family cap of \$400 for the summer) is required at the time of registration to ensure placement. **Deposits will be credited towards the cost of respective weekly tuition. The balance for each week of camp tuition, after deducted deposit, is due no later than three weeks prior to the week of camp attendance.** After that time, students with unpaid balances will lose their deposits for, and placement in reserved weeks.

Enrollment is anticipated to fill up quickly, so please register early to ensure your preferred schedules. Registrations received after April 2<sup>nd</sup> will be accepted on a space-available basis and placement is not guaranteed. Thank you in advance for your understanding, as we are trying to accommodate many families. We look forward your student's participation and a fantastic summer at Camp K.I.D.S.!
